From the desk of Father Baier...

I'm thankful to be home from my travels and back with the parish community. I had the opportunity to walk some of the Camino de Santiago, 36 miles. It was beautiful and it was great to meet people along the way. I visited many beautiful and meaningful churches including the Shrine of St. Anne near Nantes, Carmel at Liseiux, Fatima, and on its 1000th anniversary Mont St. Michel. In almost every church I visited I lit a candle for this community. I also made a special trip to visit Omaha Beach where so many American soldiers died and others won a victory as Allied forces fought into Nazi occupied Europe. There I prayed for courage, similar to what those men had. It was a whirlwind of a trip, but very powerful and outstanding. The magnificent history and churches of Europe speak of a long standing faith of many of our own forefathers and foremothers who came from Europe. Nonetheless the faith there is not being practiced widely and a secular culture is even more than here in America, I think, becoming the new narrative and norm. This was sad to see. Many of the places were culturally Catholic but the practice of the faith, going to Mass, and praying as individuals and families was not so present. Even the clergy that I met along the way, although there were friendly and nice, they seemed to lack the engaging zeal necessary to reach those in dark places. I'm not saying that I have that necessary zeal, but I'm praying for it. It is daunting facing the powers of darkness in this world. Christ is the light. I hope and pray that St. Paul, OR and the parish and the school here do not

follow the same example of the churches of Europe. For so many the churches of Europe are

symbols of the past. Our parish must be an active parish and not merely a monument. Jesus is present in our parish both in the blessed Sacrament present within and in us as a people when we gather to worship.

I did a holy hour inside the parish church at Mt. St. Michel and lit a candle for the people of our parish.
