## From the desk of Father Baier...

Years ago I went on a Holy Desire retreat with Dr. Bob Schuchts for the Archdiocese of Seattle's priests. It was a retreat that began to help me with needed healing and trust in my own life. Dr. Bob Schuchts is the author of the *Be Healed* book that I gave out to parishioners in the Easter Season. In addition to being an author he gives retreats, conferences, and is a very unique and genuine person. He and Archbishop Sample have become friends through the work that Archbishop Sample has done with him and Archbishop Sample brought Dr. Bob to work with all of the priests in the Archdiocese of Portland a couple of years ago. This interest in healing has urged the Archbishop to offer a retreat for *Healing the Whole Person*, by Dr. Bob to be offered here locally. It will be:

November 30-December 2, 2023 (Thursday and Friday evening, and all day Saturday)

It will be at Our Lady of Lavang Catholic Church in Happy Valley Oregon

Registration for the conference will be open at 7am on August 28. Nonetheless the Archbishop would like you to be aware of it and to put it on your calendars. I am hoping to spread the word about this conference because all of us need healing. Simply deciding to forget the past with its wounds and to move on does not heal one. As one professor told me, if you don't deal with your issues you will inevitably transmit them to everyone around you.

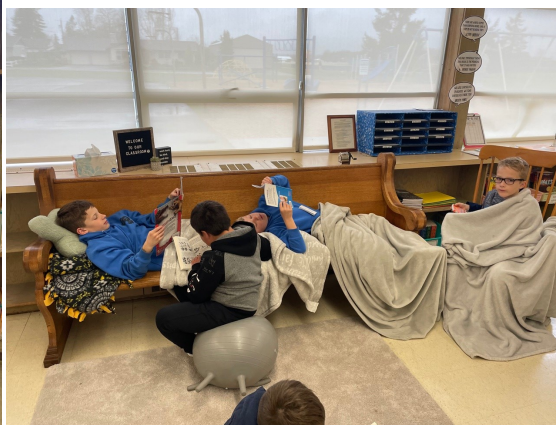
