From the desk of Fr. Baier...

Friday was the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. When we talk about the heart in biblical terms we talk about the essence, the core, of who someone is. In Jesus we see his loving spirit of sacrifice for us, as he died on the cross, and as he led the apostles. It was a blessing that on the Sacred Heart of Jesus we received news that Roe versus Wade was overturned. Since 1973 people have prayed for an end to legalized abortion in the United States and for the protection of the unborn. Through their heroic efforts and the courage of our supreme court justices the legality of abortion is once again brought to the level of the states. Of course Oregon, which has been deemed by some a “death state”, will not be changing its laws anytime soon. Not only will abortion remain legal in Oregon, but perhaps it will become a magnet state for out of state abortions. Many are troubled by the division that this will cause in our nation. However, I must consider how many children in the womb will not be silently killed. For our part as Catholics this victory is not the end of the campaign. We need to continue to support mothers, especially single pregnant women, so that they feel they have the means and the support to either have their child or to give it up for adoption. We need to help people realize that the child in the womb has rights to life just as we all do. Archbishop Sample in his statement added the following, “While the Church has done so much to help women and men heal from abortion, provide support to women who choose life, offer love and compassion to former abortion workers, and address the reasons why women seek abortions and offer meaningful alternatives, we cannot count that as enough. We must not rest in our efforts until the day no one chooses to pursue an abortion. The mercy of God knows no bounds, for both the unborn child and those women and men who have sadly experienced the tragedy of abortion in their own lives. I pray for the profound healing only Jesus can bring.”

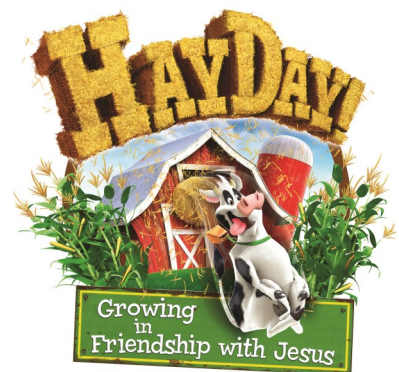
